## Annual Report June 2018

Dear Friends of Fair Hill,

At Julia deBurgos School, a seven year old boy sat holding his head, trying to read with his Reading Buddy. Our volunteer asked the teacher what was wrong. The teacher replied that the boy's father had been deported the day before. The stress level of children living in deep poverty is increased by new immigration policies.

Your gifts bring to Fairhill schools 35 caring reading tutors, 8 parent classroom aides, a full library for 900 students, thousands of gift books to take home, ESL for parents. Our school principal credits the partnership for an enthusiastic culture of reading and higher scores. Our community work includes voter registration, voter education, and lobbying in Harrisburg for fair school funding.

Our School Partnership, part of the city-wide Read By 4th, aims for children to read on grade level by the end of 3rd grade. Those who don't are much less likely to graduate from high school and make it out of poverty.

Our five-acre historic site is an oasis of peace and abundant gardens where children play, adults walk and rest, teens grow 1400 pounds of fresh produce for the neighborhood. School groups and tourists visit to hear about the great 19th C. leaders of abolition and women's rights and to think about what we are called to do today for justice and peace.
