


3,500 books distributed

We were able to bring in local author Thembi Palmer to visit three of our partner school libraries. Students stretched, jumped, danced, and giggled as they enjoyed her new book and each received copies for their own home libraries.

Youth Interns

Local middle and high schoolers enjoyed a summer full of gardening, leadership, and communal stewardship opportunities. They assisted with grounds work, trained to be tour guides, and helped lead our Summer Festival. They also got the chance to work with the Philadelphia Orchard Project and visit Vetri's Teaching Kitchen.

Reading Promise Festival

Our festival was one of 55 events that took place throughout the city as a way to celebrate the joy and power of literacy. Held at the grounds, it included a poet-tree, paper making, literacy games, storytelling, and puppetry. Plus, we gave out over 500 new books!

Bethune Elementary Library

We're delighted to announce that we are going to be opening another school library this fall. Volunteers spent the past year collecting, cataloging, and shelving books for our young readers. Since the school district does not currently fund school libraries, being able to provide new books, read alouds, and information literacy skills is essential.

With the hiring of full-time Green Space Director, Tito Caba, we will be able to offer continued programming for our youth interns. Meeting weekly, they will improve their gardening skills, serve as community ambassadors, and learn about future career opportunities.



Carriageway Repair

The grounds are at the heart of our work and where our mission and programming emanate. In addition to perserving its history, we are also committed to ensuring safety and accessibility to visitors. The carriageway, dating back to the 1850s, is buckling in areas due to tree roots and we will be restoring it in sections in a way as to not harm our precious trees.

Hartranft Parent Assistants



After honing our program over many years at de Burgos Elementary, we will be expanding our literacy work by providing Classroom Literacy Assistants at Hartranft Elementary. Bilingual parents will be hired to support literacy and family engagment in the kindergarten classrooms. This partnership will build upon the library work that we are already doing at Hartranft.
